

Bill Gates Says 'Misinformation' Led To Covid Deaths & Compares Wearing Masks To Wearing Pants

Description

USA: Microsoft billionaire Bill Gates has claimed that misinformation, from non mainstream news sources, has led to covid deaths.

During a panel discussion in Munich last week, Gates said that 'vaccine hesitation' enhanced by misinformation had led to the deaths while also comparing the wearing of face masks to wearing pants

The <u>Daily Caller</u> reports While <u>speaking</u> on a COVID-19 panel at the Munich Security Conference, Gates referred to the amount of "misinformation" surrounding his role in the handling of the virus to be "wild," before appearing to mock critics of himself, Dr. Anthony Fauci and other public health figures. "You almost have to laugh about it. I mean, you know, Dr. Fauci and I are just killing millions of people to make money," Gates quipped. "You know, <u>hydroxychloroquine's</u> this miracle cure that ... he and I have masterminded, avoiding people saving their lives by taking this thing."

Gates added, "there's no doubt that the misinformation, enhanced vaccine hesitancy and that maps to hundreds of 1000s of deaths. There's no doubt that the idea that, you know, we need the freedom not to wear a mask, you know, and that that's some, you know, thing that you've got to show that in many cases that led to spreading the disease into locations where elderly people had very high death rates."

Gates appeared to scoff at the arguments made by politicians and individuals opposed to mask mandates, before jokingly comparing grievances against compulsory masking to those against wearing pants in public.

When asked, Gates responded, "well, that's interesting. You know, what is the downside of wearing a mask? I mean, it's got to be tough. You know, you have to wear pants." Imitating his political opponents, Gates feignedly whined, "I mean, this is tough.
