USA: The FDA Administration's "Vaccines and Related Biological Products Advisory Committee" is scheduled to meet on June 14 and 15 to talk about the C-19 jab for children between six months and five years.

The agency currently has opened the site for comments. So, the comments shared on or before June 7 will be presented to the committee.

Until now, the site has 5,119 comments.

FDA is establishing a docket for public comment on this meeting. The docket number is FDA-2022-N-0904. The docket will close on June 13, 2022. Submit either electronic or written comments on this public meeting by June 13, 2022. Please note that late, untimely filed comments will not be considered. Electronic comments must be submitted on or before June 13, 2022.

The <https://www.regulations.gov> electronic filing system will accept comments until 11:59 p.m. ET at the end of June 13, 2022. Comments received by mail/hand delivery/courier (for written/paper submissions) will be considered timely if they are received on or before that date.

Comments received on or before June 7, 2022, will be provided to the committee. Comments received after June 7, 2022, and by June 13, 2022, will be taken into consideration by FDA. If the meeting is canceled, FDA will continue to evaluate any relevant applications, submissions, or information and consider any comments submitted to the docket, as appropriate.

Please note that if you include your name, contact information, or other information that identifies you in the body of your comments, that information will be posted on <https://www.regulations.gov> .*

If you want to submit a comment with confidential information that you do not wish to be made available to the public, submit the comment as a written/paper submission and in the manner detailed (see "Written/Paper Submissions" and "Instructions").
