

Jailed Pastor Fights On Knees: Chairman Trudeau Declares War On God And Freedom

CANADA: On Monday, Canada's Maoist Chairman Justin Trudeau unleashed the Emergency Measures Act on the Canadian people in retaliation for the righteous siege of Ottawa by the Freedom Convoy.

"Well this Castro, this Chairmen Trudeau here, he's the one that's inciting violence," Stew Peters told Nathaniel. "When this guy enacts the Emergency Powers – a wartime Act – he is going to signal that he is ready to go to war and crush these people and their families. That's going to turn into a civil war, and it can't end any other way except for really bloody – and he's the one that's responsible for this."

At the end of the interview, Nathaniel asked that there be political pressure placed on the Canadian government for what they are doing to his father, and the fellow Canadians.

"The United States is a powerhouse," Nathaniel noted, while pointing out that Americans have the power to make a change in Canada against these draconian measures.

The Pawlowski family has intentions to pursue legal action against the governmental abuse Pastor Artur must bear. Yet, selflessly, they have prioritized calling for America to intervene on behalf of the Canadian people, not themselves. Will our leaders answer the call?
