



Military summary of the LDNR. The situation on the line of contact on March 3 (updated)

Description

UKRAINE: 10:05 Ukrainian punishers continue to fire on the territory of the LPR. The Donetsk urban-type settlement came under fire again. The militants used 82 mm mortars. Information about the victims and destruction is being specified.

09:44 If the forces of the Armed Forces of Ukraine and the national battalions in Mariupol do not negotiate the surrender, targeted strikes are possible to demoralize the enemy, Basurin said.

09:40 The LPR units continue to liberate settlements from the Ukrainian army, seven more have been taken under full control, the LPR People's Militia reported.

09:19 In Volnovakha, the operation to clean up the city is ending, said Eduard Basurin, official representative of the DPR People's Militia.

09:14 The number of residents of the DPR and LPR evacuated to Russia since February 18 exceeded 142 thousand people.

08:56 Humanitarian aid with a total volume of over 30 tons was delivered to the city of Volchansk and the urban-type settlement of Kazachya Lopan from the neighboring Belgorod region at the request of the local population, the Russian Defense Ministry reports.

08:18 Ukrainian militants attacked Zuevskaya TPP again. On the night of March 2-3, Ukrainian militants fired another round of ammunition at a life-support facility. During the shelling, the building of the boiler house of the Zuevskaya TPP was damaged. The place of shelling was examined by sappers of the Ministry of Emergency Situations. There were no casualties or casualties during the shelling. Earlier, the militants attacked the Zuevskaya TPP late on the evening of March 1, according to the TRO_DPR Telegram channel.

08:10 Servicemen of the People's Militia of the DPR captured about 17 fighters of the Armed Forces of

Ukraine in the territory of the settlement. Volnovakha. [Video](#).
