

Ottawa Police Chief Resigns

## **Description**

CANADA: Ottawa Police Chief Peter Sloly **has resigned**, according to the *Toronto Sun*'s Brian Lilley and confirmed by the <u>CBC</u>, which notes that "Sloly has faced criticism for his handling of a truck convoy protest that has caused major disruption to Ottawa's downtown core."

Sloly will publicly announce his departure after the Ottawa Police Services Board meeting today, according to the *CBC*.

As the Post Millennial notes, Last week, Sloly said that there was "absolutely [no]" plans to resign as

police chief, telling Newstalk 580 CFRA that he "came here to do a job."

"I came here to do a job and I'm going to get that job done all the way through," he said, according to CTV News. "Absolutely committed, have a great team here, great officers, we've got great partners in the city. We're going to get this done."
