



Tucker Finally Admits Horrifying Voter Fraud – Zuckerberg Sponsored Government Elder Abuse, Cover Up [VIDEO]

Joining Carlson was Michael Gableman, the Special Counsel to Wisconsin Assemblies, who detailed how the social platform Facebook and CEO Mark Zuckerberg played a significant role in elder abuse. "We had a wave of massive election bribery, in which government officials in the five Zuckerberg-sponsored cities participated, as well as what you related when you introduced your audience me, which is the government sponsored elder abuse, all to wring out votes from people who frankly were victimized by the very people at the Wisconsin Elections Commission who are supposed to keep our voters safe."

Enlightening Carlson about the size and scope of fraud that supposedly took place, Gableman exposed how Zuckerberg set aside \$330 million to help defeat Trump in the election. Stunned, like most, Carlson said, “It’s just — it’s all beyond belief, and you’d think that people who wanted to defend democracy would be outraged. But of course, they’re in favor of it.”
